

Basic Care / Do's & Don'ts

Please use these basic guidelines to care for your new spa cover and it should reward you with many years of good service.

Do ...

- Ensure your cover is locked down when unattended
- Leave your cover off for at least one hour after adding chemicals to your spa
- Check that all the cover locks are undone before lifting the cover
- Wash your cover regularly with mild soap and rinse with fresh water
- Spray the zip's and sliders regularly with lubricant (RP7 or similar) to ensure they will open in the future if necessary

Don't ...

- Don't drag cover over rough surfaces when moving or storing your cover
- Don't leave your spa unattended when the cover is unlocked or removed
- Do not sit, stand or walk on your cover, try to avoid pets sleeping on your cover and definitely kids jumping on it
- Don't lift or pull your cover by its straps, flaps, skirts or heat seal—use handles only
- Don't clean your cover with any silicone or petroleum based product—we recommend 303 Aerospace Protectant

Remember ...

The core of your cover is made of styrene foam, and will break if stressed. Make sure not to exceed the maximum recommended static load, keeping in mind that an object (child, pet etc.) falling or jumping will be much heavier than their static weight.

Use the maximum static load details as a guide, however keep in mind that the foam insert is designed to hold these weights over the whole span of the foam, rather than in one concentrated point. A heavy weight in a small concentrated area (such as an adult's weight concentrated by kneeling on one knee) greatly increases the chances of foam damage.

Maximum Recommended Static Load ...

- Spa Cover by Pinz—25kg static load bearing capacity
- Cover Superior by Pinz—75kg static load bearing capacity
- Cover Superior Plus by Pinz—125kg static load bearing capacity

Please keep in mind that damage to foam inserts is not covered under your spa cover warranty.
